Serves as a national clearinghouse of information on election administration.



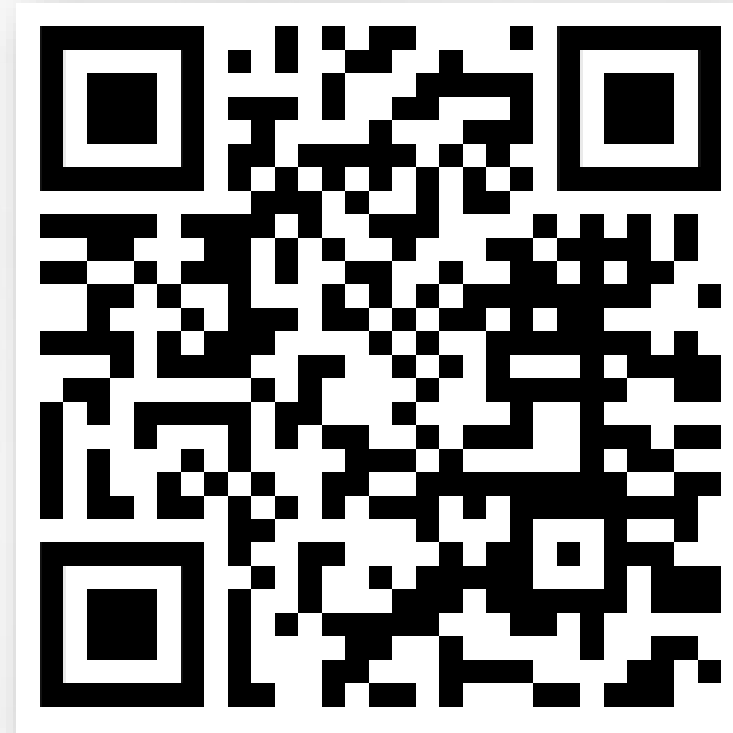
Distributes, administers, and audits the use of HAVA funds.

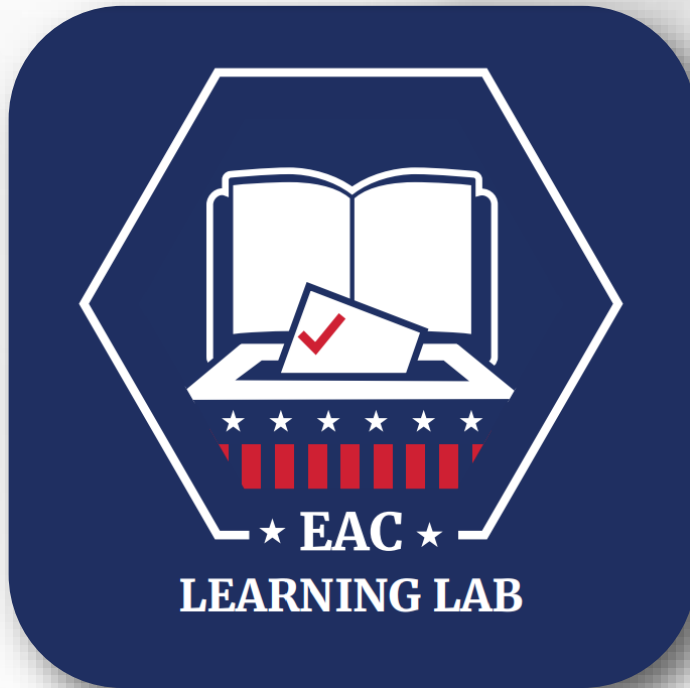

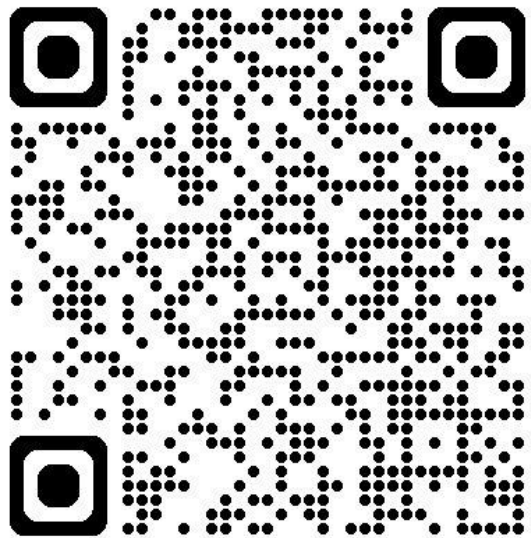
How many eligible voters with disabilities are in your jurisdiction?
