Mission: Help state and local election officials improve the accuracy of their voter rolls, register eligible citizens, reduce costs, and improve efficiencies in the voting process.

ERIC is the most effective and efficient tool available to help election officials maintain the integrity of their voter rolls.



Public charity non-profit membership organization **founded in 2012 by seven states** - 4 led by Republicans and 3 led by Democrats.

Members govern ERIC. Each member's Chief Election Official designates a Member Representative to serve as a voting member of the Board. Currently, 25 members (24 states + DC).

Members fund ERIC. New members pay a one-time fee. All members pay annual dues, which are set by the members.



Voter Reg: Full name, mailing and residential address, DOB, SSN4, last activity dates

MVD: Full name, mailing and residential address, DL/ID#, DOB, SSN4, last activity dates

Social Security Limited Access Master Death File: Full Name, DOB, SSN, Date of Death

Voter Reg and MVD data must be submitted at least once every 60 days.



- Exclude confidential records
- Exclude party affiliation and racial data if recorded
- Exclude known noncitizens
- States apply a cryptographic hash on the DOB, SSN, DL/ID # (See website for details.)

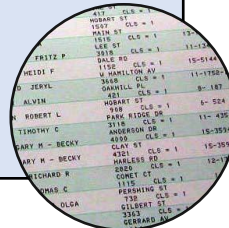

Delivering on our mission 2023 - 2024:

- 1,040 List Maintenance Reports, including deceased voters, in-state movers, cross-state movers, and in-state duplicate registrations.
- Reports identified about 8.2 million likely out-of-date records and deceased voters for members to act on.
- EBU Reports identified about 1.7 million potentially eligible but unregistered individuals.
