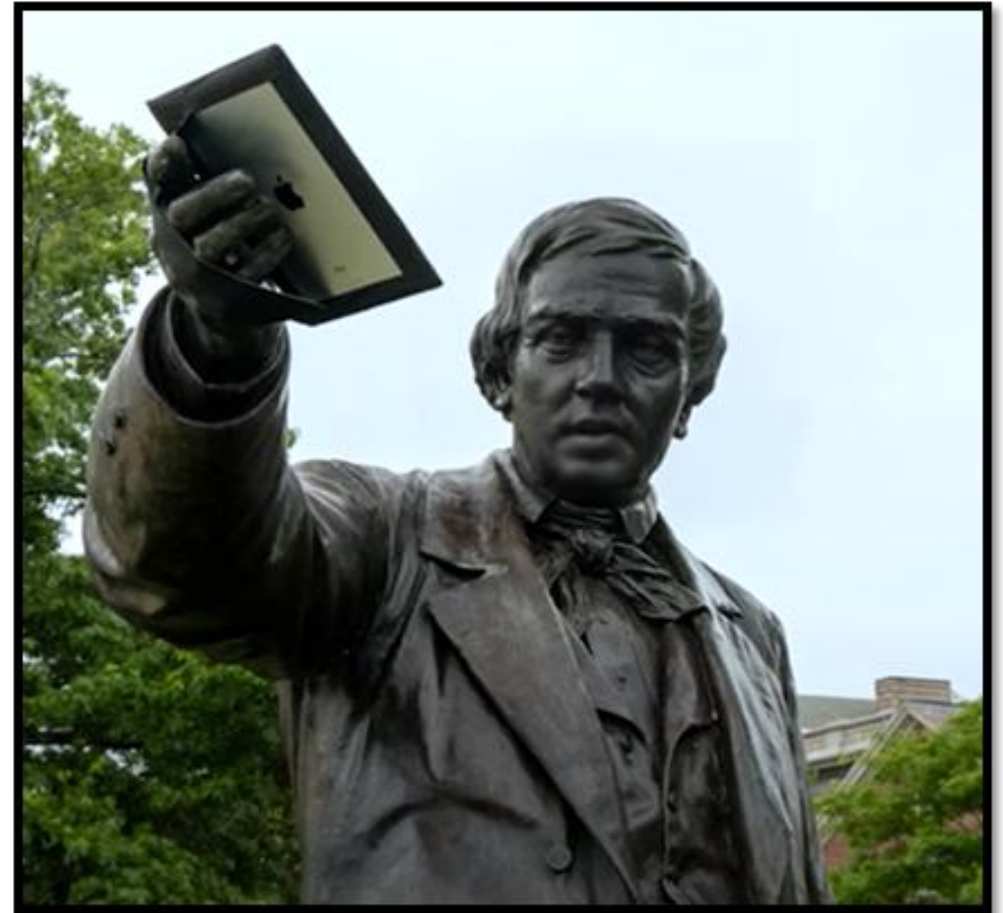

# 2. ELECTION RESOURCES



**NH House of Representatives**

**400 seats (2-year terms)**

- 1) 18 years of age;
- 2) Registered voter;
- 3) Resident of the state for 2 years immediately preceding the election;
- 4) Resident of the town or ward the candidate is running to represent.

**Currently:** 221 Republicans; 177 Democrats; 1 Independent; 1 vacancy

**House Speaker:** Sherman Packard (R), Rockingham 16

**Majority Leader:** Jason Osborne (R), Rockingham 2

**Minority Leader:** Alexis Simpson (D), Rockingham 33

NH ELECTION KNOW-HOW: **ELECTIONEERING**  
*Live Free or Die!*

Definition: "Visibly displaying or audibly disseminating information that a reasonable person would believe explicitly advocates for or against any candidate, political party, or measure being voted." RSA 652:16-h.

- Outside the 10-foot path for Voter entrance, and within the designated
- hold signs
- talk with Voters

NH ELECTION KNOW-HOW: **POLLING PLACE LAYOUT**  
*Live Free or Die!*

NOT SURE OF YOUR POLLING LOCATION? SCAN HERE!

TO RECEIVE A BALLOT, PROCEED TO:

1. the **BALLOT CLERK** if you are already a registered voter at your polling location.
- OR the **SUPERVISOR OF THE CHECKLIST** if you need to register to vote. Be sure to have documents proving 1. Identity; 2. that you are at least 18 years old; 3. domicile; 4. citizenship.
- OR the **NO PHOTO ID table** if you have no photo ID to prove who you are.

2. **WITH YOUR BALLOT, PROCEED TO:** either a voting booth, a sit-down voting table with privacy screen, or the accessible voting.

3. **WITH YOUR COMPLETED BALLOT, PROCEED TO:** the Ballot Box OR Electronic Ballot Counting Device. Note: For hand-count ballots, the moderator will cast your ballot to ensure ballot accuracy.

*Live Free or Die!*

**VOTE! VOTE! VOTE! VOTE! VOTE! VOTE! VOTE!**

**DID YOU KNOW?** In NH, you can register:

- ✓ With the endorsement of the National Association of Secretaries of State, National Voter Registration Day is a "nonpartisan civic holiday dedicated to celebrating our democracy." **This year, National Voter Registration Day is September 17, 2024!**
- ✓ With your local town or city clerk, up to 6-13 days before the election.
- ✓ At a scheduled local supervisors of the checklist meeting, 6-13 days before the election.
- ✓ At the polls on election day.
- ✓ By absentee, if you qualify.
