What is an Apostille?

Apostille is an official certificate that authenticates a public official's signature (including notaries public) on a vital record or document to be used outside the United States.

| Common Documents Requiring Apostille in CA | |

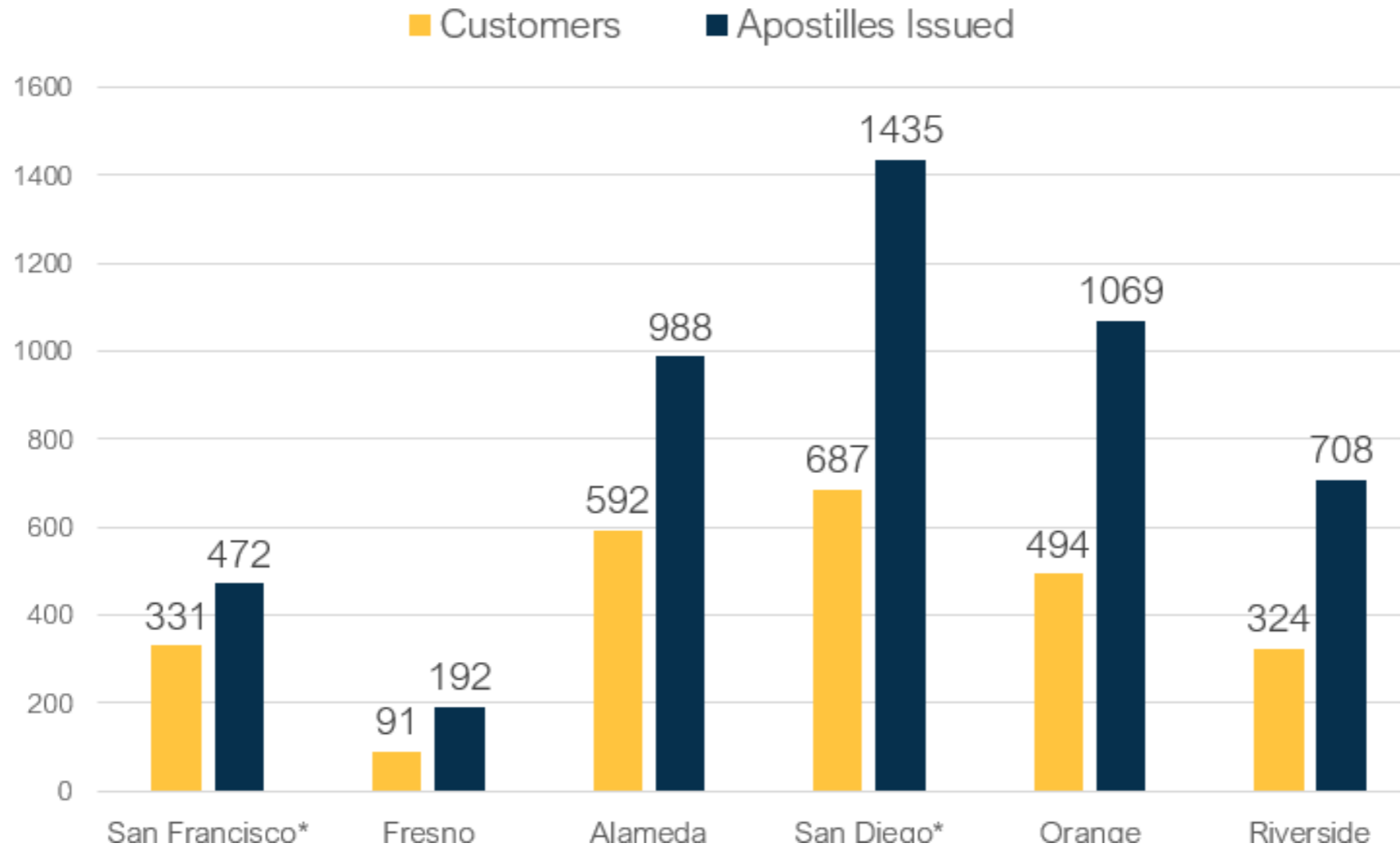

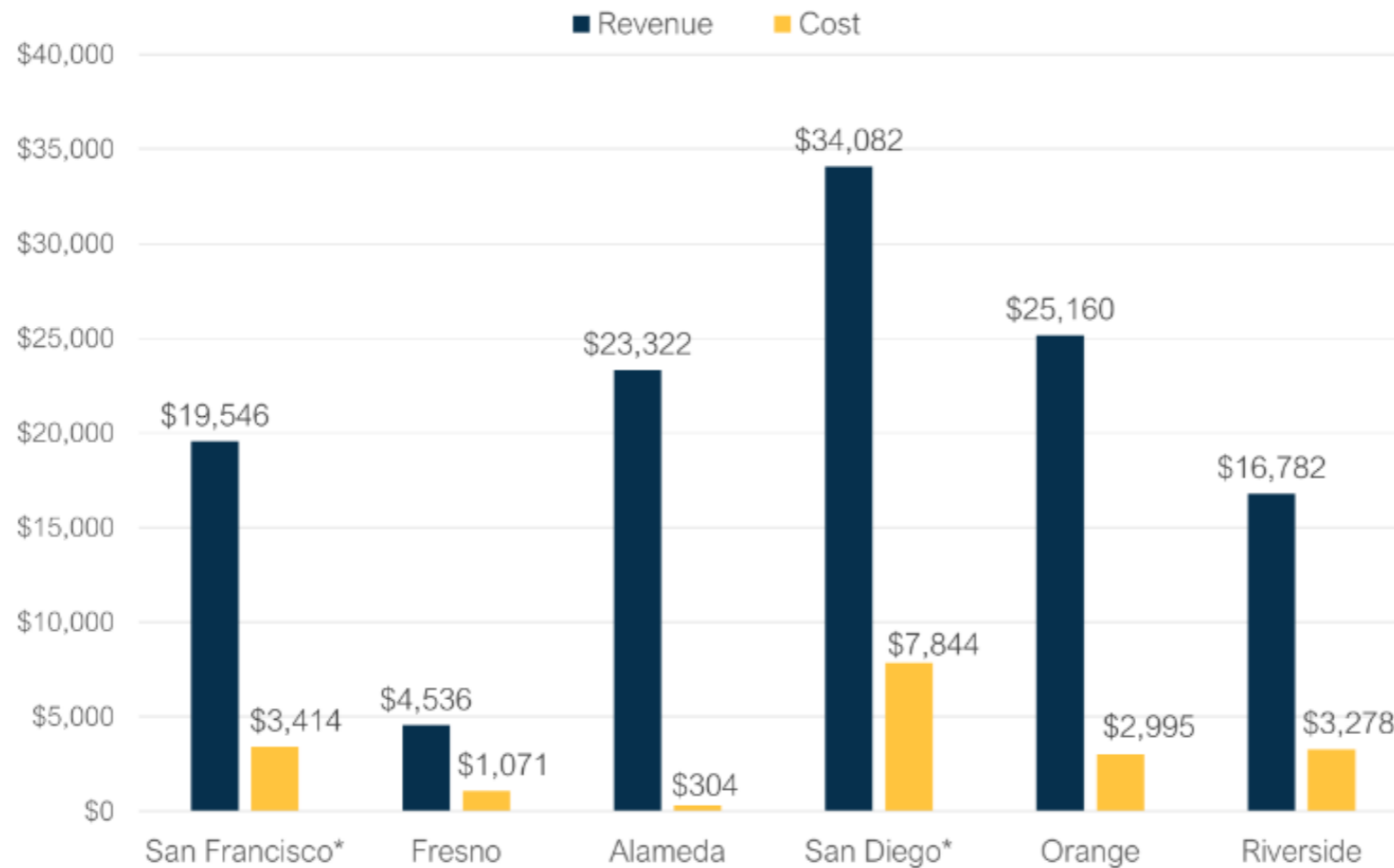
