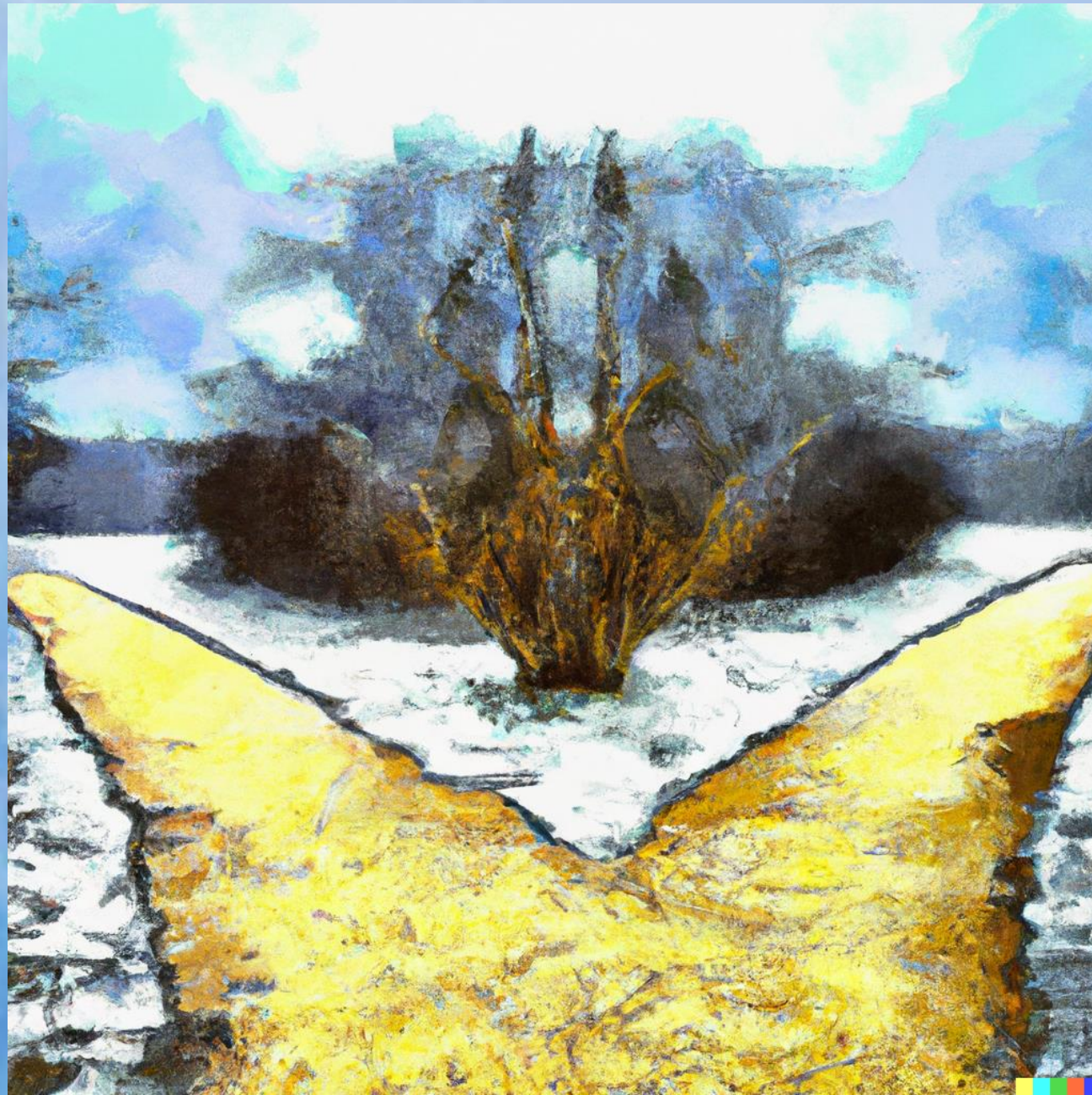


Vulnerability Disclosure Program

A Vulnerability Disclosure Program (VDP) is a structured framework that allows security researchers, ethical hackers, and the general public to report vulnerabilities they discover in an organization's systems, software, or services. The goal of a VDP is to provide a formal process for identifying and addressing security weaknesses before malicious actors can exploit them.

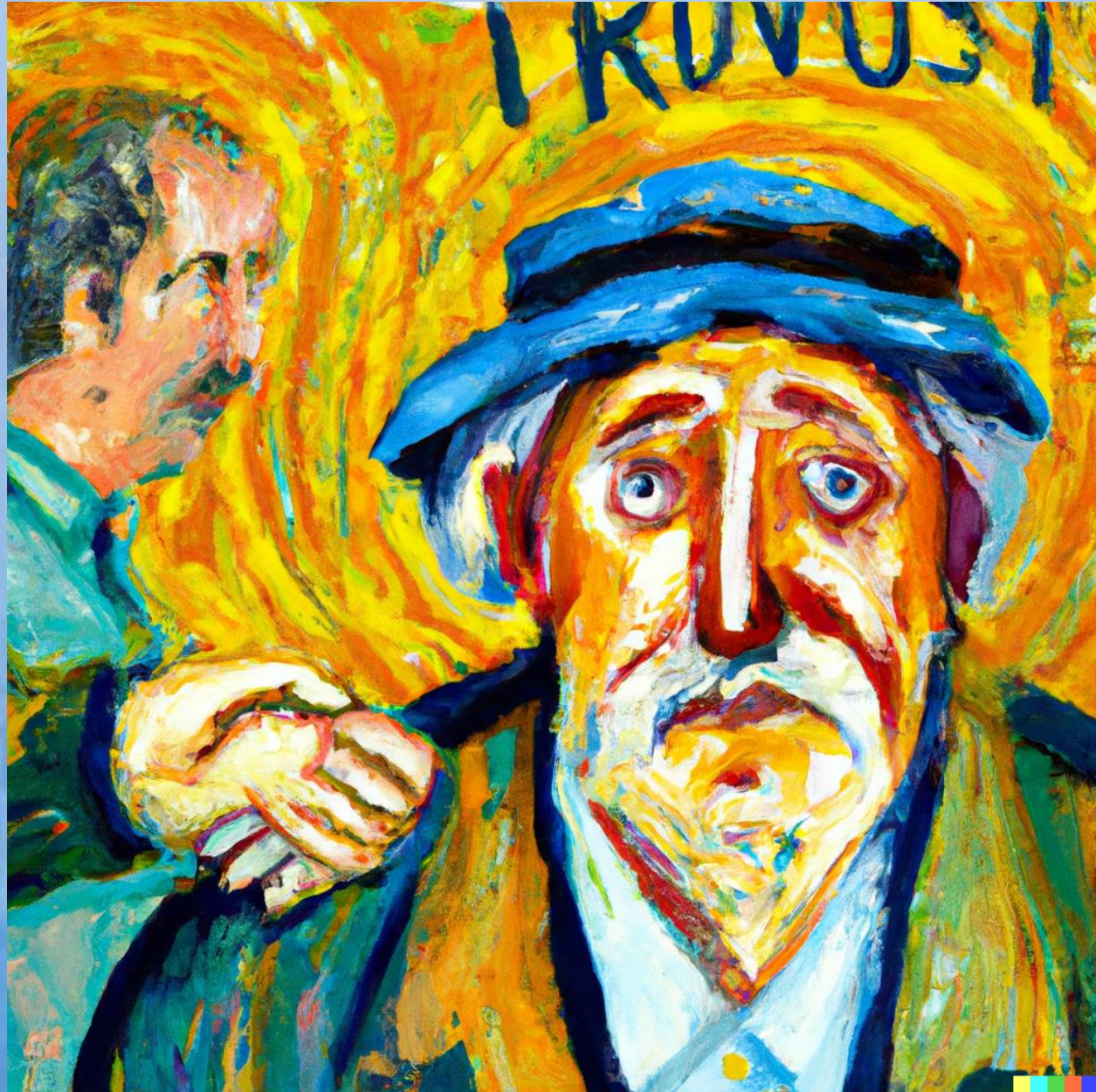

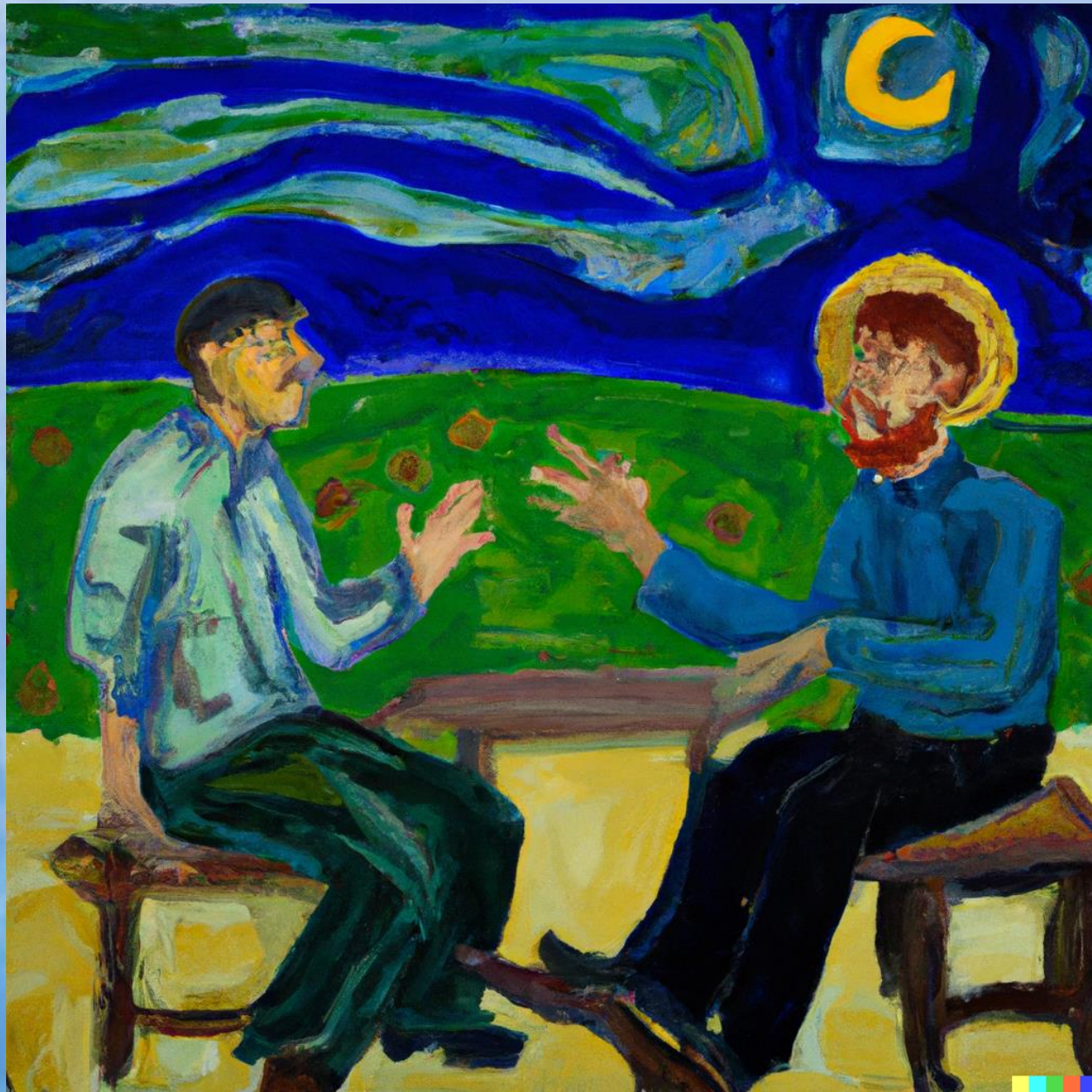

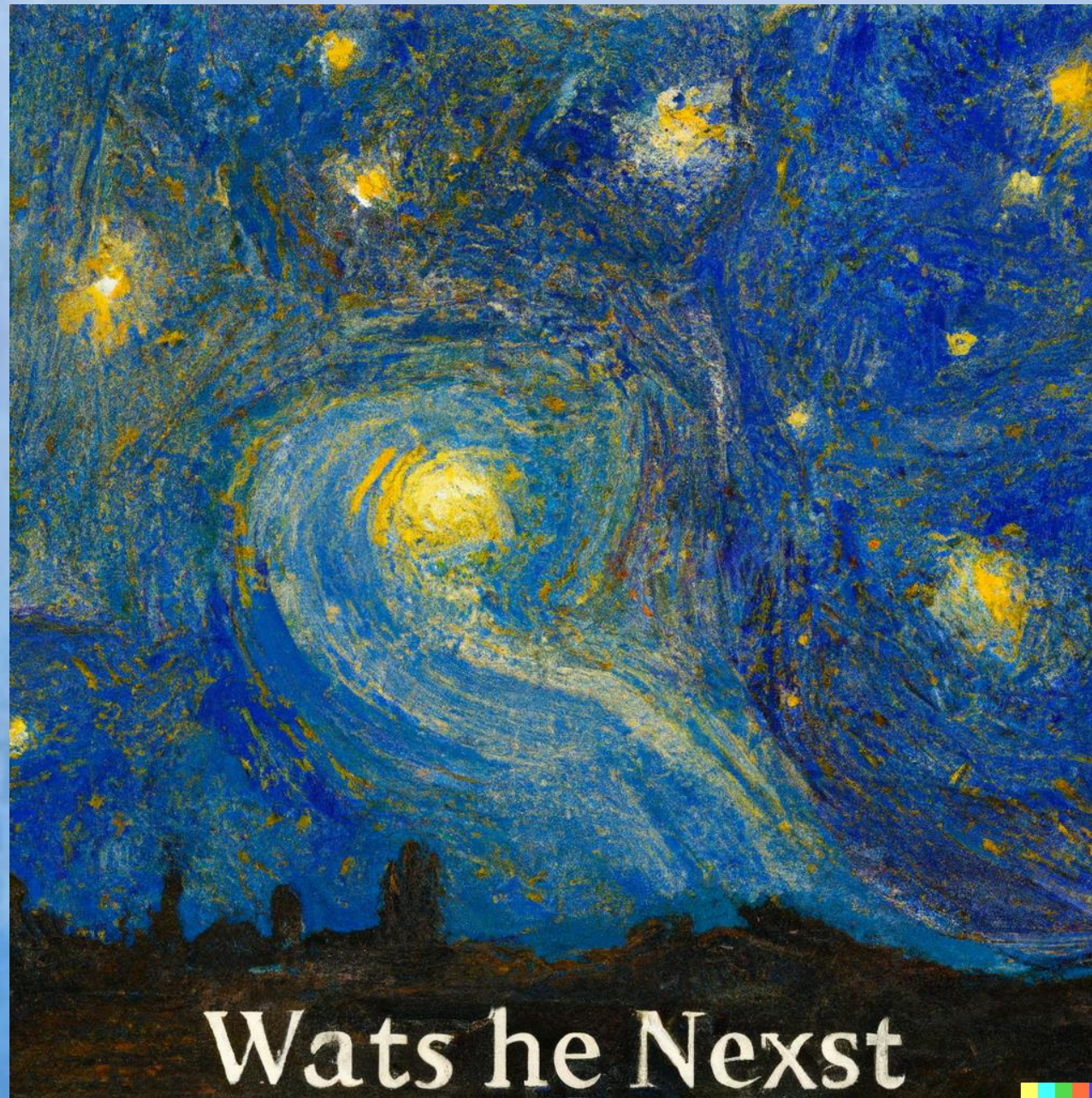
