# Stock Market Simulator

- Part of the project includes an annual Indiana Stock Market game in which students receive a fictitious \$100,000 to invest in a portfolio over a 10-week period.
- Students are introduced to concepts related to financial decision-making, specifically saving, and investing.
- Roughly 8,000 K-12 students participated, and the top scorers from each region were awarded certificates and a luncheon at the Indiana Statehouse






- Cryptocurrency values can fluctuate significantly and frequently, making them highly volatile.






# JA BizTown Camp



- The Division engaged 190 campers at Junior Achievement BizTown's summer camp with an educational detective game focusing on preventing investment scams.
- Through puzzles and codes, campers learned to recognize scam red flags and protect their information, promoting financial safety.
- The interactive game aimed to equip children with skills to become responsible investors in the future.



### HOW TO PLAY

Form investigation teams.

Go through a series of puzzles and earn keys.
