Controlling Conflicts

- ★ Lieutenant Governor Duties
 - Chief Election Officer (UCA 67-1a-2)
 - Oversee all elections and functions relating to elections
 - Render all interpretations and decide election law controversies
- **★** Cannot abdicate statutory authority
- ★ Established independent advisor
 - For controversies or questions arising in gubernatorial race
 - Provides formal advice, which lieutenant governor can accept or reject

Director of Elections

- ★ Simple matter where law is clear
- ★ Standard review of statute
- ★ Make decisions and implement normal processes

Independent Advisor

- ★ Needs further review
- ★ Director consults legal counsel & independent advisor
- ★ Independent advisor writes recommendation

Lieutenant Governor accepts or rejects recommendation
